



A Quick Guide to the Indiana Choice Scholarship

Clinton Christian School | Goshen, Indiana

If you've assumed private Christian education was financially out of reach for your family, you're not alone.

Many families are surprised to discover that Indiana offers a program that can significantly reduce the cost of private school tuition.

At Clinton Christian School, the Indiana Choice Scholarship Program allows qualifying families to apply a portion of the state education funding toward their child's tuition.

For many families, this program makes Christian education far more affordable than they expected.

This guide provides a simple overview of how the program works and how CCS helps families navigate the process.

What Is the Indiana Choice Scholarship?

The Indiana Choice Scholarship allows a portion of the state education funds allocated for your child to follow them to the school of your choice—including Clinton Christian School.

In simple terms:

Instead of your tax dollars only supporting your local public school, the state may apply those funds toward tuition at a participating private school.

The goal of the program is to give families greater flexibility and choice in their child's education.

For many families, the scholarship covers a significant portion of tuition.

Who Qualifies?

Eligibility for the Choice Scholarship is primarily based on three factors:
Indiana residency | Household income | Household size

For the 2026-2027 school year, families may qualify if their annual income does not exceed 400% of the amount required for the federal Free or Reduced Lunch (FRL) program.

Because income limits increase based on family size, many middle-income families qualify.

If you're unsure whether your household may qualify, our admissions team is happy to help you review the guidelines.

How Much Does the Voucher Cover?

Voucher amounts vary depending on your student's public school district of residence.

Each district has a per-student funding amount determined by the state. A portion of that amount may be applied toward tuition at Clinton Christian School through the Choice Scholarship.

In the graphic you'll see estimated voucher award amounts for some of the most common school districts represented by Clinton Christian School families. These estimates help give a general idea of how the program may apply to your situation.

For many CCS families, the Choice Scholarship covers a significant portion of tuition, making Christian education far more financially manageable than they expected.

How the Process Works

We work closely with families to keep the process simple.

Step 1: Apply for admission to Clinton Christian School

Step 2: Submit required income documentation

Step 3: Upon acceptance of enrollment, we complete the voucher application

Step 4: We will provide documentation from the state for parents to sign

Step 5: Voucher money is paid directly to the school over the course of the school year.

Our admissions team walks you through every step. You will not navigate this alone.

Common Questions

Does accepting the voucher affect my taxes?

No. Participating in the Choice Scholarship does not change your tax filing status.

Do families reapply every year?

Yes. Families complete a simple annual verification process to maintain eligibility.

Is funding limited?

The state funds the program annually, and we encourage families to apply early.

What if our income changes?

Eligibility can be reassessed if your financial situation changes.
